THE MISSION OF THE BRIDGE

Empower adults experiencing homelessness in Dallas with the tools to homeless recovery as they move into sustainable housing.

Fiscal Year 2020 presented unique challenges for The Bridge. COVID-19 mandated that we reduce our capacity to 50%. Though the number of Guests we served decreased, we saw an increase in the percentage of Guests on campus connecting to services thus furthering their journey to homeless recovery.

HOMELESSNESS IN DALLAS



During the 2020 Point in Time count by Metro Dallas Homeless Alliance, homelessness in Dallas County decreased by **1.4%** over 2019.

were found to be homeless on that day.

* The 2020 Point in Time count was conducted in January 2020. These numbers do not reflect the increase in homelessness we saw due to the effects of COVID-19 throughout the remainder of the year.




WHO ARE OUR GUESTS?


Luckily, The Bridge is here to help our Guests out of their situation and set them on the path out of homelessness.
